Interpreting Service

Arriving by Bus



The Royal Derby Link Bus operates a 10 minute service, Monday to Friday (Saturday every 20 mins). Each bus runs between the Royal Derby Hospital and the London Road Community Hospital, calling at 'The Spot' in Derby city centre. The bus goes into the grounds of both hospital sites. Arriving by Train

Derby Train Station is within walking distance of the London Road Community Hospital. If your appointment is at the Royal Derby Hospital, the Royal Derby Link Bus can be caught from near the main entrance of the London Road Community Hospital. Alternatively taxis are available outside the station if you have difficulty walking.

Car Parking

Spaces are available in the following car parks (see map overleaf):

Apart from car park 2 all car parks have disabled spaces. All spaces within the car parks are chargeable (including the disabled spaces).

The car parking charges vary depending on how long you stay. Tariffs available on the Trust website: www.derbyhospitals.nhs.uk.

On arrival take a ticket and pay at the pay station when you return.

For those attending regularly, **reduced weekly tickets are available** from the car park office (located at car park 6 - see map)

PATIENT TRANSPORT ON-SITE

Use our free Yellow Bus Service which runs continuously around the site, connecting all the car parks and entrances. Simply wait at the nearest Yellow Bus stop and catch the next one that comes along.

Patient & Visitors are permitted to also use the Royal Derby Bus Service for free transport around the RDH site before it exits the Hospital grounds.
